2006-2007 CERTIFIED GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL MANAGER PLAN CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA CHAPTER AGA

The following outlines the Central Pennsylvania's Certified Government Financial Manager Plan for the 2006-2007 Program Year:

1. Support Current CGFMs

The Chapter will support CGFM by wearing the pin, adding the CGFM designation after our names on business cards, reports, etc., and place the CGFM designation on nametags worn at AGA monthly meetings or seminars. We will publish CGFM members' achievements in our newsletter and on our website. We will work with Commonwealth Comptroller Eckert to once again ensure that Governor Rendell issues a letter in support of our recognition of March as being CGFM Month.

2. Market CGFM

The Chapter will once again market the CGFM by showing the AGA DVD at our September luncheon meeting. We also plan to re-send correspondence to our State Civil Service Commissioners requesting them to consider allowing the CGFM certification to replace existing work requirements for specific civil service jobs in the accounting, auditing, and budgeting classifications.

3. Assist Potential New CGFMs in Attaining Certification

Discussions are being held to determine whether funds could be awarded to persons as an incentive for them to take the training course. Also, we are discussing the creation of a CGFM Library and the development of a study group where recent CGFMs would provide guidance to potential CGFMs. Guidance will include tips and pointers for first time examinees.
